The divisors 15, 12 and 9 are considered the standard credit course load taken by a full-time student at the undergraduate, master's and doctoral level respectively. Each first professional student is counted as one FTE. Includes health sciences and first professional students. Includes all students enrolled on-campus and off-campus.
