

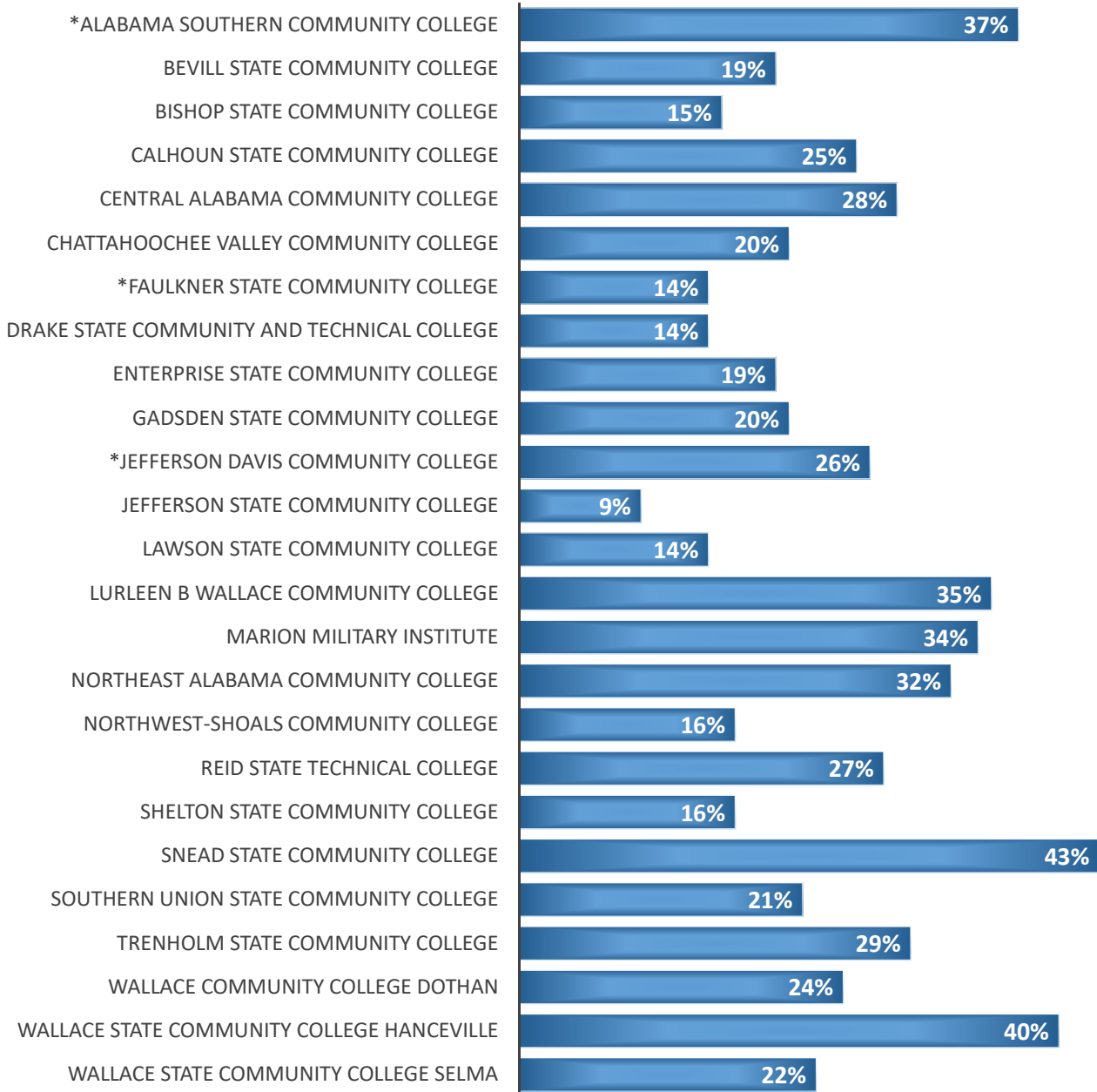

## Alabama Public Two-Year Institutions

### Graduation Rates of Full-Time, First-Time Degree/Certificate-Seeking Undergraduates Within 3 Years (150% of Normal Time) to Program Completion

#### 2017 Graduation Rates based on 2014 Cohorts



**NOTES:** Graduation rates are defined as the total number of individuals from a given cohort of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates who completed a degree or certificate within a given percent of normal time to complete all requirements of the degree or certificate program; divided by the total number of students in the cohort of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates minus any allowable exclusions.

\*Beginning Fall 2017, these institutions were combined to create "Coastal Alabama Community College". The combined graduation rate is 22%.

Ingram State Technical College is comprised of incarcerated inmates and therefore is not included in this report.
