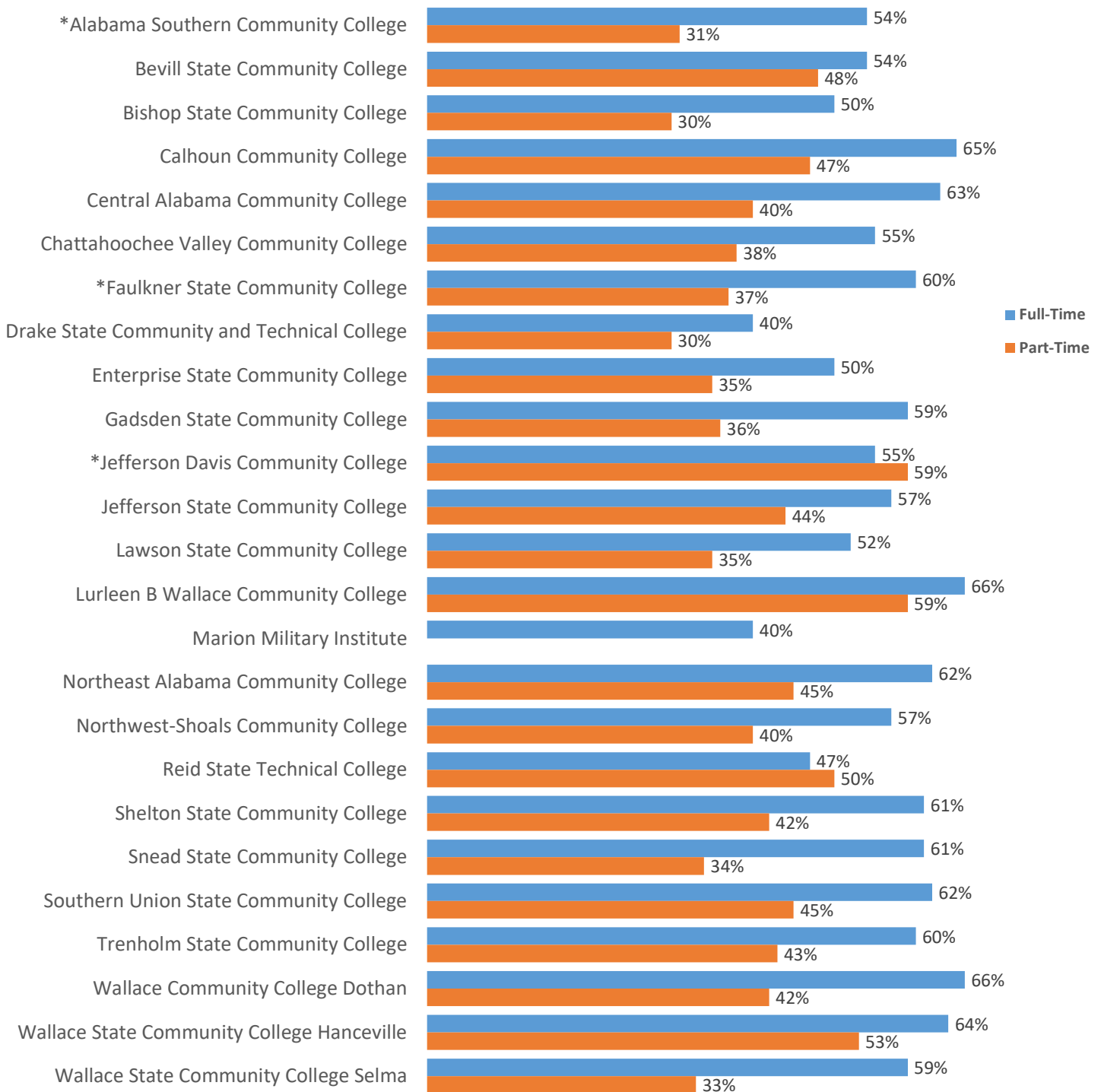

## Alabama Public Two-Year Institutions

### Retention Rates of First-Time Degree/Certificate-Seeking Students, by Attendance Level: Fall 2016 Cohort



**NOTES:** Retention rates are measures at which students persist in their educational program at an institution, expressed as a percentage. This is the percentage of first-time degree/certificate-seeking students from the previous fall who either re-enrolled or successfully completed their program by the current fall. Academic reporting institutions report retention data as of the institution's official fall reporting date or as of October 15, 2016. Program reporters determine the cohort with enrollment any time between August 1 - October 31, 2016 and retention based on August 1, 2017.

\*Beginning Fall 2017, these institutions were combined to create "Coastal Alabama Community College". The combined full-time retention rate is **58%** and the part-time rate is **40%**.

Ingram State Technical College is comprised of incarcerated inmates and therefore is not included in this report.
