NOTES: Graduation rates are defined as the total number of individuals from a given cohort of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates who completed a degree or certificate within a given percent of normal time to complete all requirements of the degree or certificate program; divided by the total number of students in the cohort of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates minus any allowable exclusions, disaggregated by race/ethnicity.

"OTHER" race category includes American Indian or Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, Two or More Races, Race/Ethnicity Unknown and Nonresident Alien.

*Beginning Fall 2017, these institutions combined to create "Coastal Alabama Community College". The combined graduation rate for race/ethnicity: Overall is **22%**, Black is **20%**, White is **23%**, Hispanic is **18%**, Asian is **15%**, and Other is **29%**.

Ingram State Technical College is comprised of incarcerated inmates and therefore is not included in this report.
